
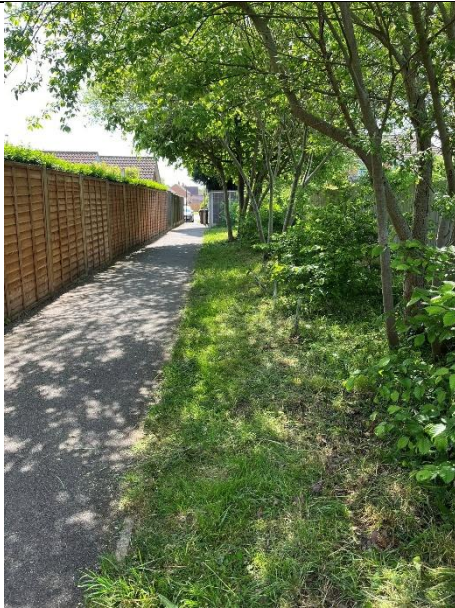


Task #	25 – 09	Date:	1 <sup>st</sup> May	
Task:	Buttermere Way – Lane Hedgerow			

A very warm morning but with a bit of shade for us in places thankfully

We had 13 hot and sticky volunteers out today along the footpath at the top of the Buttermere Way - this is the footpath where we have planted approx 60m of mixed native hedgerow over the last few years.



It was our spring task there to remove as much bramble, nettle, and bindweed from around the base of each tree to try to ensure it gets as many nutrients and as much light as possible. The hedgerow has really begun to hold its own and is thickening up and growing really well.

We have left a reasonable patch of nettle on one sheltered corner too.
