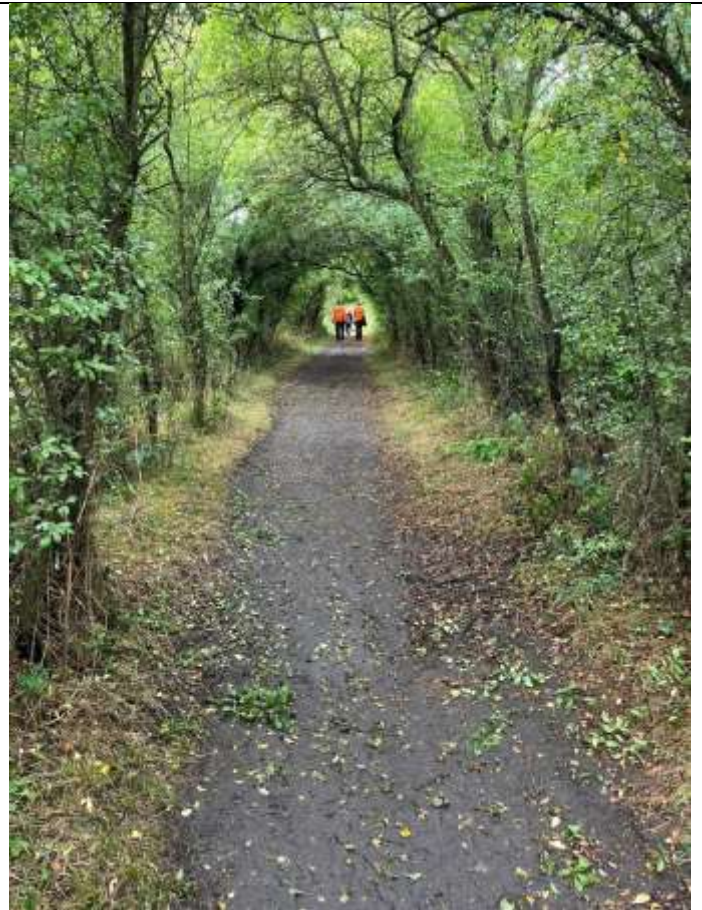
We were also able to remove lots of litter as we went - filling a mighty 10 bags just in that short distance, mainly thanks to some adventurous ditch diving.
