Area/ Task:	Strancliffe Lane - part 2			

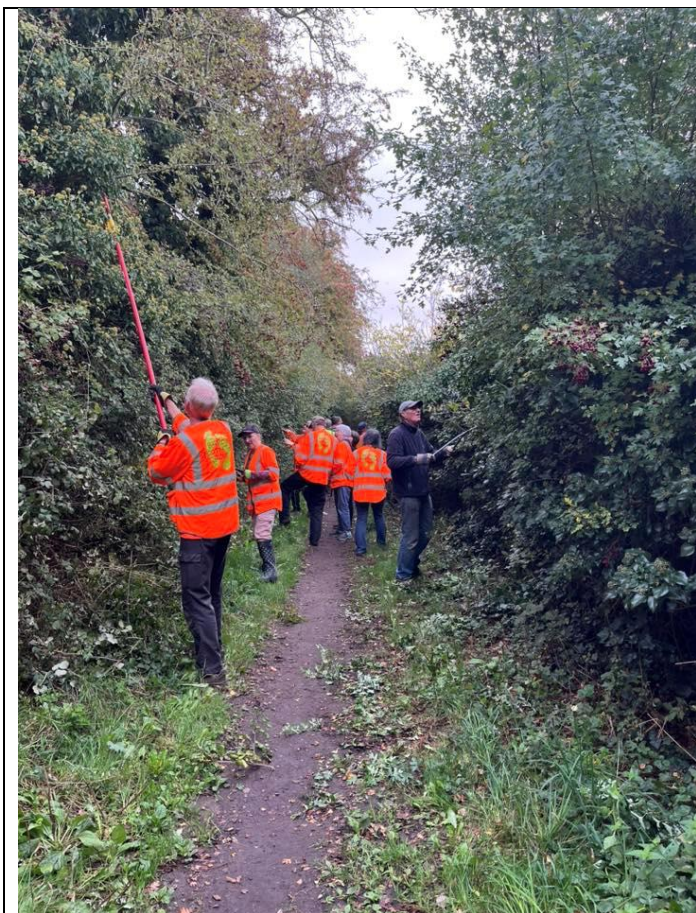
Another very busy, and exhausting task today finishing cutting back the length of Strancliffe Lane down to, and across, Nottingham Road and we split into a couple of groups to get the whole bridleway finished.

Lots of very old, and very tough bramble was cleared away to widen the path over a few pinch points along the track. Some areas had been getting narrower over the years - easily seen as the path having taken a bit of a meander to avoid the bramble bushes.

There were also a couple of trees that had been slowly strangled by ivy and were only upright because of the amount of ivy around them. Where these were clearly dead and unstable, we cut them back too.

The whole bridleway really does feel much wider and far more open now - and will hopefully dry out quicker in the wetter months.

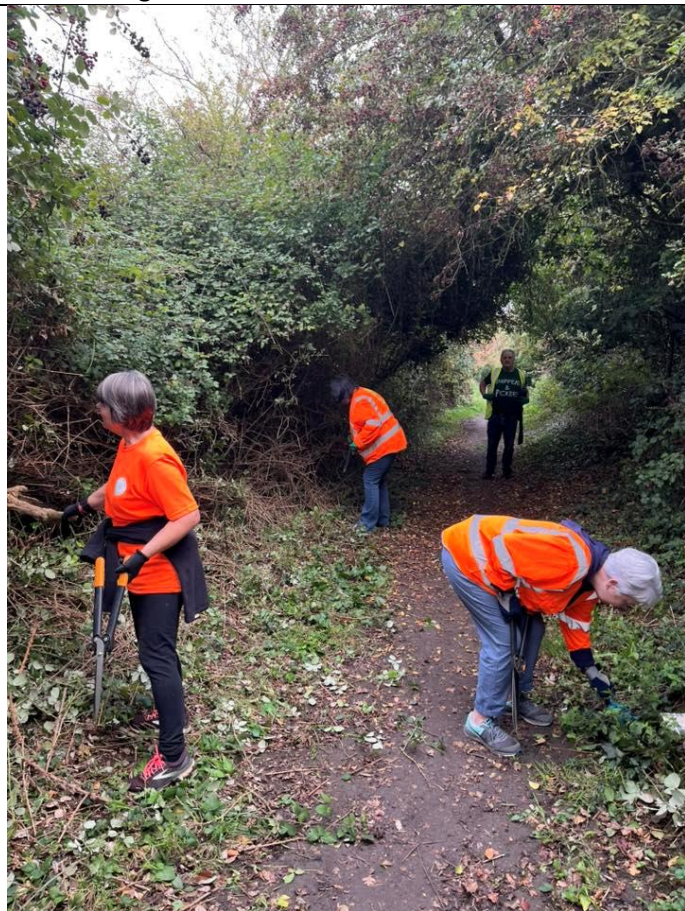




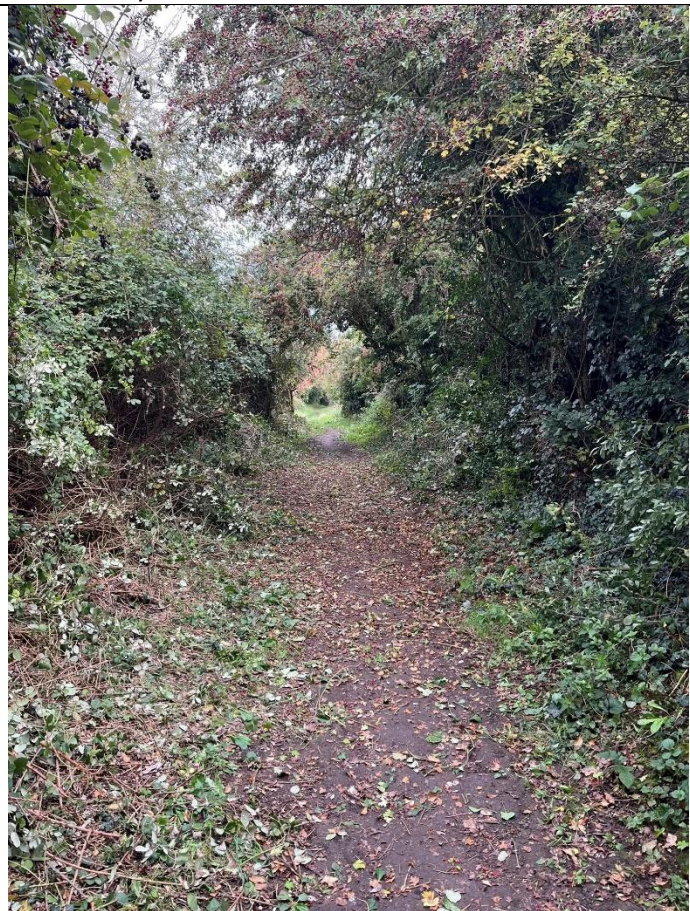
Just starting
