Area/ Task:	Rookery Path – Cotes Road, to Bridge St – over the railway bridge			

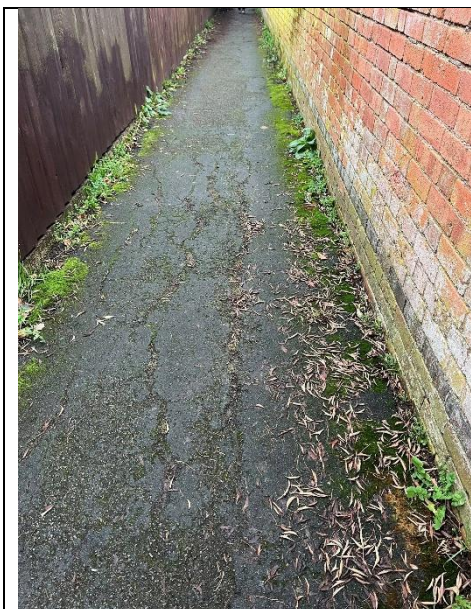

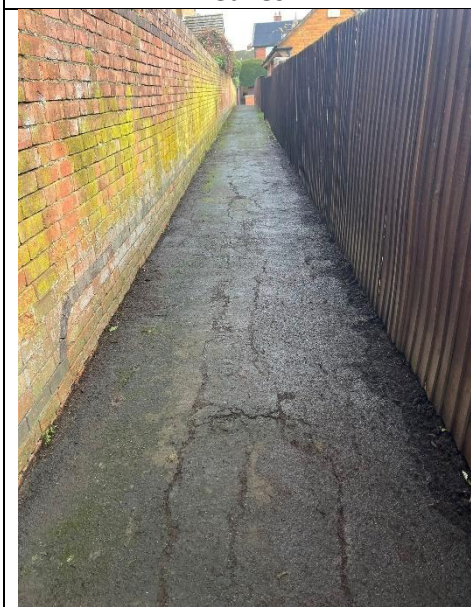
