Area/ Task:	Millennium Park – Old Wildflower area			



We were so lucky with the weather today - finding ourselves in a small window of dry conditions with a little breeze - perfect for the task at Millennium Park.

We've looked after the old wildflower area for a few years now, gradually cutting back overhanging tree branches, removing brambles and ivy, and each year in late winter /early spring we remove the fallen leaves and thatch from the ground to keep the soil from getting too rich for the wildflowers to flourish. We use all the green waste to create new or add to existing habitat piles, which are really beginning to rot down nicely.

It's hard work but a very satisfying task to be part of, especially when we stop for a few minutes to take in the improvements we can now clearly see. Lots of young flowers pushing through which should soon be seen and enjoyed from the path nearby.
