Area/ Task:	Fishpool Brook paths – Newton Close towards Melton Road			

Lots of volunteers out today so we were able to split into 2 teams to get lots of work done along Fishpool Brook path.

One team tackled the bridge across the brook between Swan Close and Newton Close - clearing the moss off the bridge decking planks and cutting back brambles and overgrowing greenery. They did a great job - huge improvement. The state of the decking will be reported to Barrow Parish Council for further action by the responsible authorities.

The other team concentrated on clearing the leaf debris from the edges of the path from Swan Close to the bottom of Branston Avenue. Lots of mud was removed from the path and put back onto the surrounding green areas to add nutrients back into the area. They also made a start of reclaiming the edge of the path from the encroaching mud on the path towards Melton Road - even finding and exposing a drainage hole. Again, the team made a huge difference.
