We then moved along the footpath over One Man Bridge to the smaller green space there next to the path. All the same type of bag and all new offerings to the poo fairy - very few were hidden in the grass or covered in mud leaving us thinking it was more of a recent 'dump' rather than flood litter. Absolutely horrible to find but so glad we were able to remove it from our environment.
